



Uniform & Dress Code Policy

Students should be in dress code at all times.

Plain, Solid Color Polo Shirt w/collar (any color ~ no writing)

Tan/Khaki or dark navy-blue pants, shorts, skirts/skorts*

Polo style dresses are permitted (Plain, any color)*

Shorts/skirts/dresses ~ no more than 1" above the top of the knee

Closed Toe Shoes

Tennis shoes must be worn daily.

No sandals, boots, or open-toed shoes are allowed.

Light-up shoes and shoes with wheels are NOT permitted.

School Spirit T-shirt and jeans or jean shorts (Fridays only)**

No cutoff jeans, jeans with frays, or jeans with holes

No loose jewelry.

Jewelry, hats, colored hair and hairstyles that distract from the learning environment will be considered a violation of the student uniform policy.

Please send a spare outfit (with undergarments) with student name on each item.

MAS allows for reasonable accommodations based on a student's religion, disability, or medical condition as discussed with the Principal and respective parent/guardian.

Parents will be contacted to bring a change of clothes or to pick up their child if the uniform policy has been violated.
